District	Amount	Uses	Status
Crosby ISD	\$109.5 Million	Bond revenue will be used for a new elementary school, a sixth-grade school, renovations to a middle school campus and an addition to Crosby High School. The district is also decreasing the property tax rate by 2 cents.	Passed
Deer Park ISD	\$70.6 Million	The bond finds will rebuild Carpenter Elementary, relocate Bonnette Junior High stadium, install turf at Abshier Stadium, renovate two junior high schools and demolish the old San Jacinto Elementary.	Passed
Katy ISD	\$609.2 Million	Bond revenue will be used to build one new high school, two junior high and 3 elementary schools, plus infrastructure for new and existing campuses.	Passed
Lamar CISD	\$445.4 Million	Bond revenue will purchase land, build a new high school, junior high and three elementary schools. The District will also make improvements to current facilities and purchase technology and buses.	Passed
Pasadena ISD	\$135 Million	Bond revenue will be used for an intermediate school, band and orchestra instruments, technology upgrades, a replacement elementary campus, new buses and facility management.	Passed

Spring Branch ISD	\$898.4 Million	Majority will be used for to replace nine outdated elementary schools	Passed
Stafford MSD	\$62 Million	The bond includes a new middle school and new administration building, plus several renovation projects, including an early childhood center.	Passed
Tomball ISD	\$275 Million	Bond funds would be used to expand Tomball Memorial High School and build a new elementary school, junior high, agricultural barn and swim training facility.	Passed
