Note: We are not the only screenings available to people, and we only capture a fraction of those affected. While we cannot draw conclusions beyond what is reported, MHA's mental health screening provide the **most direct, real-time measure** of mental health/overall wellbeing in the greater Houston region. What this information demonstrates to us is that the impact of a variety of variables is real and appears to be spreading and accelerating.

This screening program is identifying a help-seeking population earlier than ever before, giving us new opportunities to address mental health concerns long before they become Stage 4 crises. Finding partners to promote screenings as online, free, and anonymous, and sharing the data is important to help mental health organizations and professionals support the most vulnerable in our communities.

By Category (rounded)

ADHD

• 82% of people screened were likely experiencing symptoms of ADHD.

• Alcohol or Substance Use

80% of people screened showed likely alcohol or substance use.

Anxiety

94% of people screened were likely experiencing moderate to severe anxiety.

Bipolar

• 50% of people screened positive for bipolar disorder.

Depression

- 36% of people screened were likely experiencing mild to moderate depression.
- 58% of people screened were likely experiencing moderately severe to severe depression.
- Overall, 94% of people screened were likely experiencing some degree of depression.

Eating Disorder

• 99% of people screened were at risk for an eating disorder.

Parent (Your Child's Mental Health Test)

• 75% of parent screens taken showed a child at risk for emotional, attentional, or behavioral difficulties.

• Postpartum Depression

• 76% of people screened showed probable depression.

Psychosis

• 78% of people screened showed a possible risk for psychosis.

PTSD

• 90% of people screened positive for PTSD.

Youth

• 77% of youth screened were at risk for emotional, attentional, or behavioral difficulties.

- 4. Loneliness or Social Isolation









Household Income












